- TASA is open to students in grades 4 & 5. Classes meet on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- Return the registration form to the TGS main office. Priority will be given to forms returned by Sept. 29th, but rolling enrollment is acceptable if space allows.
- I can have a maximum of 14 students per day. Students can sign up for one or both days. If you sign up for both, please make a 1st and 2nd choice in case of over enrollment.
- Students will go to the computer room for our class when walkers are dismissed. Home schooled students should arrive at 3:00. Pick up is at 5:30pm at the TGS main entrance. There is NO BUS HOME. If you need to pick your child up early, come in to the room, text or call my cell 593-6542 (new # from last year) and I will send them out.
- I'll send reminders and updates via e-mail (if you don't have e-mail, give me your phone number) each week about the Clubs.
- Occasionally, I will put out calls for materials like **beach rocks (we need these this session!)**. These can be dropped off at school or I can pick them up.
- **We need donations of SNACKS!** We average 12 students per class. You can pick a date to send snacks in for (call me or e-mail) or just drop off something at the class when you pick up your child and I can use it for the next week. TASA Art Club Descriptions Fall 2017

meets Tuesdays and Wednesdays After School until 5:30

Paste Paper Oct. 3, 4

We will spread thickened acrylics on paper and use reductive techniques to create both patterned and one of a kind designs. As well as being hung on a wall, the finished papers can be used as covers for the Bookbinding class.

Bookbinding Oct. 10, 11, 17, 24 (No class Oct. 18- early release day)

Students will make their own journals- one to keep at Art Club and one to bring home. We will also explore accordion books and scrolls.

Halloween Makeup & Costume Oct. 25 & 31

Students can practice and perfect their makeup for Halloween night. We will learn how to make realistic looking wounds (cornstarch and gelatin based), fake blood and other Zombie essentials. Students will be able to take home the wounds to use on Halloween. They can get help with their costumes as well.

Painted Rocks Nov. 1, 7, 14, 15 (No class Nov. 8- early release day)

Students will paint rocks and arrange them into changeable sculptures, ie. Mini Stonehenges.

Duck Tape Sculpture Nov. 28, 29, Dec. 5, 6

Make sculptures and wearable art using duck tape! From basic wallets to wearable shoes, create whatever you can imagine.

Block Printing Dec 12, 13, 19, 20

Students will design, carve and print their own designs to create cards and frame-able prints. We will use easy to carve foam blocks.
